1. SUMMARY OF ISSUE:

The City of Chilliwack places great emphasis on ensuring a continuing reinvestment in the water and sanitary sewer systems. The annual cost to provide water and sanitary sewer services increases with inflationary cost adjustments to labor, contracts and materials, along with annual levels of capital investment and reinvestment. The water and sewer functions operate as self-sustaining services, funded through user fees with no property taxation subsidization. It is recommended that an increase of 7.32% be applied to water and sanitary sewer fixed and metered user rates.

WATER USE RATES

1. REGULAR METER SERVICE:

The following minimum charge billed quarterly, based on meter size:

2. BULK METER SERVICE:

Where a bulk water meter in lieu of individual meters is utilized for a multiple dwelling complex, multiple unit complex or mobile home park, a minimum quarterly charge of $\frac{28.1730.23}{28.1730.23}$ shall be levied on each dwelling, unit or mobile home pad.

3. UNIFORM QUANTITY CHARGE:

Notwithstanding meter size, a quarterly uniform quantity charge of $\frac{1.661.78}{1.661.78}$ per 100 cubic feet of water consumption; or in the event that a meter cannot be read, either:

- (a) an estimate of water consumption; or
- (b) the City may change the period end to the date the meter is read.

4. HYDRANT USAGE CHARGE:

Handling charge:\$100.00 each time a hydrant is used (except for fire-fighting)Usage charge:\$ 25.00 per day

5. WATER METER TEST FEE: \$100.00

Payable as a deposit, which shall be subject to Sections 15 and 16 of this Bylaw.

Schedule "B"

SANITARY USER RATES

1. STANDARD USER RATES:

The quarterly sewer user rates shall be the sum of the basic fee and the consumption fee, as applicable.

2. CALCULATION OF RATES:

- (1) For commercial developments, all charges will be based on readings from a single meter unless an application for individual meter readings is made. To allow charges to be determined by individual meter readings, the type and location of each meter must be approved by the City.
- (2) The quantity of water consumed shall be the most recent amount recorded by the meter through which water is delivered to the property less the immediately previous billed reading.
- (3) In the event that a meter cannot be read, either an estimate will be made by the Collector or the Collector may change the period end to be that date on which the meter is read.
- (4) For all single family residential properties or duplexes and mobile home pads without water meters, the quarterly sewer use charge shall be based on an assumed consumption of 2,000 cubic feet.
