# STAFF REPORT ON City Hall Parking Lot Expansion RFEI

#### 1. SUMMARY OF ISSUE:

Six expressions of interest were received in response to the City Hall Parking Lot Expansion Request for Expression of Interest (RFEI). The work includes the supply of all labour, materials and equipment to construct additional City Hall parking at 46039 Southlands Drive.

#### 2. BACKGROUND:

- 2.1 The recent addition to City Hall not only provided additional space for staff, but also new meeting rooms used to facilitate larger meetings with partners and community groups.
- During peak time, the visitor parking across from City Hall at 46019 and 46029 Southlands Drive regularly fills up, forcing visitors to search for limited parking along Southlands Drive, Southlands Crescent, in the Staff visitor parking lot, or along Brooks Avenue. Citγ staff and BC Ambulance staff are using on-street parking, which will be in high demand as the new housing regulations create increased density in the area.
- 2.3 The City purchased the house at 46039 Southlands Drive in 2021 to facilitate future civic parking lot expansion. Demolition of the existing structure on the property is scheduled to be completed in the coming days.

### 3. FACTORS:

- 3.1 Six expressions of interest from the following proponents were received in response to the City Hall Parking Lot Expansion Project RFEI.
- 3.2 A three-member evaluation team ranked the expressions of interest based on the pass/fail document submissions criteria and the following technical criteria:
  - a. Experience and Expertise of the Respondents Team (30%)
  - b. Related Project Experience (25%)
  - c. Project Approach (25%)
  - d. References (20%)

## 3.3 The results of the evaluation are as follows:
