Sorry for the delay. I thought I already responded 3.

The property is located within the AL (Agricultural Lowland) Zone, which permits an alcohol production facility in accordance with the Agricultural Land Commission (ALC) Act and Agricultural Land Reserve (ALR) Use Regulation (Use Regulation). To operate a brewery within the subject property, the requirements of Section 13 of the Use Regulation must be met. This includes the requirement that 50% of the primary food product produced each year is harvested from both the agricultural land on which the brewery is located and/or from a farm operation located in British Columbia that provides that primary farm product to the brewery under a contract having a term of at least 3 years. In addition, the food and beverage service lounge must not exceed 125 m² indoors and 125 m² outdoors.

Based on previous reviews of the brewery by the Planning Department, it is our understanding that the business is operating in conformance with these regulations. Despite this, it is the applicant's responsibility to ensure the business meets current ALC regulations as they relate to alcohol production facilities.

The portion of the property subject to the application is located within the existing building and lounge area, and as such, the increased hours of operation are not anticipated to increase noise, parking or traffic to levels greater than what is currently experienced. The <u>Community Standards Bylaw 2021, No. 5041</u> will be in effect and in force, from time to time.

Hi Jennifer,

In regards to Traffic and Parking. I do not see an issue as the business is located in a farming area and has adequate parking already.

Traffic in this area is not very busy and usually maintains a continuous trajectory in that area.

Impact of noise is as above. Any hours of operational change will not likely affect anyone in the area due to the location being someone isolated in the first place.

Variances and zoning. The property will basically be used in the same manner as it is already. A change in the hours will not affect this.

Impact on the community. There would be minimal to no impact to the community as long as local LCLB rules are maintained. There have been no complaints noted as of this date.
