#### 1. SUMMARY OF ISSUE:

Through discussion with the Canadian Mental Health Association (CMHA) Vancouver-Fraser Branch, an opportunity for the City to apply, in partnership with CMHA, for a Plan H Healthy Communities' Community Connected Grant (maximum \$5000) and Healthy Public Policy Grant (maximum \$15,000) has been identified. The shared vision is to create a business case for addressing the increasing need for mental health support in Chilliwack, recognizing that mental health support should occur pre-crisis, during crisis, and post-crisis, and that there may be existing programs that could be leveraged. Proposed activities include data gathering and analysis; engagement of health providers and community agencies; a forum to facilitate input from the community regarding opportunities and recommendations; and development of a final business case for presentation. The proposed activities support Chilliwack Community Safety Plan objectives to address gaps in services in Chilliwack.

## 2. RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation that Council direct staff to pursue funding from Plan H Community Connected Grants and Healthy Public Policy Grants, in partnership with the Canadian Mental Health Association Vancouver, as described in the report dated April 26, 2023.
