## 1. SUMMARY OF ISSUE:

The Chilliwack Pride Society is once again hosting the Chilliwack Pride Festival. The festival will take place on Saturday August 19th, 2023 from 10:00am – 4:00pm and will involve a full day of food, art, artisans, vendors, musicians and drag performers. As with last year the event will be located on Mill Street, Wellington and Victoria Avenue and will also involve Central Community Park. As the event has moved from a Sunday to a Saturday the event hosts are working with the Downtown Chilliwack BIA to ensure that any impact to the merchants in the downtown catchment is considered.

In 2022 the City of Chilliwack provided funding support via the Community Development Funding Initiative Policy Directive C-13 and in the value of \$4,500 to offset the event costs. The Society is seeking \$10,000 in funding this year.

To further support the annual Pride Festival the City will continue to provide the park rental as well as tables and chairs at no cost (valued at \$2,000). With many hard costs, primarily traffic control, increasing for all event staff is recommending a funding level of \$5,000 for this year with the standard proviso that any excess be returned. This approach is similar to what is now being done for the Chilliwack Rotary Christmas Parade

Attached for Council's review is a site map of the event location as well as the projected budget.

Council is asked to consider the following recommendation:

## 2. RECOMMENDATION:

Recommendation that Council approve funding for annual Chilliwack Pride Festival, the amount of \$5,000 under Policy Directive C-13, Community Development Initiative Funding and that staff direct the host to complete all reporting requirements set out in said policy directive and further that any excess funding be returned.


